

MATH+ Postdoctoral Membership Application Procedure

Dear prospective postdoctoral MATH+ member,

Thank you for your interest in becoming a postdoctoral member of MATH+.

There is no official application form, instead you should email the following to Theo Roelofs at the MATH+ Office (roelofs@math.tu-berlin.de):

- a cover letter explaining why you want to join MATH+ as a postdoctoral member, including a statement in what area of the cluster (Application Areas, Emerging Fields, BMS Research Training Areas, ...) you see yourself contributing.
- an up-to-date CV, including a list of publications,
- a letter of recommendation from a MATH+ faculty member (or from the head of your research group if s/he is not a MATH+ faculty member).

The letter of recommendation should include a short description up to the present date about your academic/working relationship with the person recommending you and their plans for future projects with you. They should then say why they recommend you to become a MATH+ postdoc. They should write it in the form of a letter, but it can be sent directly to Theo Roelofs (roelofs@math.tu-berlin.de) by email as a pdf.

Your application (incl. letter of recommendation) will be presented at the next MATH+ Board Meeting and you will be informed afterwards of the result.

As a MATH+ Postdoc we expect active participation in MATH+ events, such as the MATH+ Day, talks and workshops organized by MATH+. Oher examples include assisting with interviews during the BMS Days, or to act as an initial mentor for new Phase II students. You could also become a Postdoc representative. However, the advantages and opportunities open to you are much more. See the attached pdf for detailed information.
