BMS Postdoc Application Guidelines



We are currently inviting applications for the Berlin Mathematical School Dirichlet Postdoctoral Fellowship beginning in the fall of 2026. Accordingly, applicants must have successfully finished their PhD studies before 01 October 2026.

The deadline for applications is 1 December 2025.

You are permitted to submit one application only, but you have the opportunity to save your application and return to it later. First of all, please read the following information thoroughly and then fill in the online form. Make sure that you can provide all the required information and necessary documents as we will consider complete applications only.

Please have the following PDF files (max. 1.5 MB) ready for uploading on the last page of the online form:

- Personal Statement (explaining your motivation to apply; max. 2 pages)
- Curriculum Vitae (max. 2 pages)
- Research Statement (max. 2 pages)
- · List of Publications
- University Certificates: PhD, master's and bachelor's degree certificates (or the document that serves as proof of the degree awarded). If you have not yet completed your PhD, you may submit your master's and bachelor's degree certificates only. Detailed transcripts are not required.

IMPORTANT! Please read the following before you start filling out the application form.

- · You must have JavaScript activated in your browser.
- Each PDF file must not exceed 1.5 MB in size!
- You have the opportunity to save your application and return to it later.
- After you have saved your application, you will see a pop-up window telling you that the data was saved.
- After you have submitted your application, you will (a) see a pop-up window telling you that the data was saved and (b) receive an email to confirm the submission of your application.
- You can check the status of your application at any time until 31.12.2025 by clicking on your name at the top right of the application portal's website.
- If you do not receive a notification of submission, or if you detect a problem with your application, please write to the Berlin Mathematical School at postdoc@math-berlin.de with the following information:
 - · Your full name
 - · The position you are applying for
 - The reason for your enquiry

Please note that you will be asked to add the information of three recommenders to your application. After you have completed and submitted the online form, the BMS will send each recommender an email to the address you provide asking them to submit a letter of recommendation for you. We require only three recommendations, but you may add a fourth one if you wish. Letters submitted by the applicant will not be accepted.

The deadline for letters of recommendation is 8 December 2025.
