

## Places to eat on FU campus

*Disclaimer* - this is a list containing places to eat that are most popular among the members of Discrete Geometry and Topological combinatorics group. The prices are very approximate and can differ from real ones.

<b>Mensa II FU</b>	<p>Student cafeteria            For non-Berlin students around 7€ for a meal.            You would need to get a guest card from the machine in the atrium and put money (cash only) on it. When you leave Berlin, you can return the card and get what money are still there back.</p>
<b>Info-Kafete</b>	<p>Takustrasse 9, in the basement level, room K34            A small cafe run by students, selling coffee, tea, sandwiches (half-rolls), cold beverages, warm dishes (occasionally) and more.            Prices: Sandwiches 1,10/1,20 €, coffee 1 €, cold beverages 1,00-2,00 €.            Opening hours: Mo-Fr around 9:45 am to 4:45 pm</p>
<b>Museum Cafe</b>	8-10€ for the main dish. Cards accepted.
<b>Asia Snack</b>	<p>Asian-fusion fast food.            5-6 € on average, cash only            Not much space to sit, but you can take "to go"</p>
<b>Döner</b>	<p>Don't judge Berlin Döners by this one :)            Nevertheless, 5-6€ for lunch, cash only</p>
<b>Really Good life</b>	<p>Burgers.            Somewhat more expensive than the previous options.            They accept cards!</p>
<b>BioBäck Bakery</b>	<p>They have sandwich-type things.            Relatively expensive for Berlin, around 5€ for a big sandwich.            Cards accepted.</p>
<b>Rewe</b>	<p>Grocery store. Has a salad bar.            Wednesday special - food truck in front of Rewe            Turkish breadspreads</p>

There are also more fancy places around the campus, such as Pizzeria Galileo, Luise (restaurant/café/ beer garden), Alter Krug, Cafe at Domäne Dahlem and perhaps more.
